The philosopher and academician was taken part the day before by "yellow vests", on the sidelines of the fourteenth Saturday of mobilization. On videos shot boulevard du Montparnasse, at the corner of the Rue Campagne Première, in the 14th arrondissement of Paris, he appears copiously whistled and insulted. Olivier Faure, President of the French Socialist Party, has launched a meeting at Republique Arena in Paris, Tuesday 19th at 7pm to protest against antisemitic behaviour since the last incident victimizing Alain Finkelkraut who declined to calm charges against his aggressors.
