DECLARATION OF PRESIDENT HOLLANDE AFTER THE PARIS ATTACK ON FRIDAY NOVEMBER 13-----"My fellow French citizens, as I'm speaking of the attacks of unprecedented scale are underway in the Parisian agglomeration. There are dozens of killed several lots of injuries. It is a horror. We have on my decision to mobilize all possible forces to neutralize terrorists and making safe of all relevant quarters. I also asked that military reinforcements that are currently on the Paris region, to be sure that no other attack can take place. I also convene the Council of Ministers to be held in a few minutes. Both decisions will be taken.-----

1- The state of emergency will be declared, which means that some places will be firm, traffic will be banned. And there will also searches which may be decided in Ile de France. The state of emergency will be applied on the whole territory.

2- The second decision that I made is the closure of the borders. We must ensure that no one will go to commit any act whatsoever. And at the same time as those who may have committed crimes that are unfortunately noticed if they are arrested trying to leave the country.-----

This is a terrible ordeal, again, assails us. We know from where it comes from, who these criminals and these terrorists. We have in these moments so difficult and I have a thought for the many victims, for the families, the wounded, we must show compassion and solidarity. But, we must show unity and in cold blood. Faced terror France must be strong. It must be large farms and the state authorities. We will be ...-----

We must also call each responsibility. What the terrorists want is to scare us or capture us with dread. There is indeed nothing to be afraid, there is fear.-----

But we must facing terror with a nation that knows how to defend, itself who knows how to mobilize its forces and once again we will defeat the terrorists. French citizens, we have not completed transactions, ... there are still some actions that are extremely difficult. It is currently the case as the security forces are in assault, especially in a place, in Paris. I ask you to keep all your trust here, in what we can offer to the security forces to protect our nation from terrorist acts. Long live the Republic and long live France." Declaration of President Hollande.
