"In accordance with Canada and Congo's joint commitments in the Francophonie, the strengthening of democratic institutions is essential to ensure inclusive governance, peaceful pluralism and macroeconomic growth, which will benefit the people of Congo." After already thirty-two years at the head of this small oil-producing country in Central Africa, held its inauguration Saturday, April 16 to take the oath for a new term of five years.
